

## **Mark A Socinski, MD**

Mark A Socinski, MD, is currently a professor of medicine and member of the Multidisciplinary Thoracic Oncology Program at the Lineberger Comprehensive Cancer Center on the campus of the University of North Carolina (UNC) at Chapel Hill, North Carolina, United States. Dr Socinski received his medical degree from the University of Vermont College of Medicine and completed his training in internal medicine at Beth Israel Hospital, Harvard Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts. He subsequently completed his fellowship in medical oncology at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute in Boston. Along with his colleagues, he was instrumental in the initiation of the Multidisciplinary Thoracic Oncology Program at UNC in 1995. His primary interest involves clinical trials research in all aspects of thoracic oncology. Dr Socinski is an active member of the Respiratory Core Committee of the Cancer and Acute Leukemia Group B (CALGB) as well as the American College Chest Physicians and the American Society of Clinical Oncology. He has authored or co-authored many articles, abstracts, book chapters, and monographs predominantly focused on issues in thoracic oncology.
